Time to Paint the Town Red with Geraniums

One of the annual Mission Committee's fundraisers is for the Women's Resources of Monroe County. Beginning this Sunday, March 31 through April 12, you will be able to sign up for the beautiful and hearty red geranium plants in the Narthex before and after church. Cost per plant is \$5.00; \$4.50 for three or more; and \$54.00 for a flat of twelve plants. They will be delivered on May 10. For more than 38 years, Women's Resources of Monroe County has provided free and confidential services for survivors of domestic and sexual violence in Monroe County. They provide direct services for women, children and men and education to the community. Your support makes a huge difference in the lives of the survivors.

One Great Hour of Sharing
