Many of you are not familiar with what the Presbytery does or how it affects the life of our church. As such, I will attempt to share with you some exciting things that the Lehigh Presbytery has done and is doing.

The letter from moderator Deborah Prince shared that during the November presbytery meeting a new Statement of Direction was approved which will lead us into an "exciting yet discomforting time" as we start "something new and exciting while not knowing exactly where God's Spirit will lead us."

One of first new things was announced. Moderator Deborah Prince has invited all members of the Lehigh Presbytery to this year's first Presbytery Assembly on March 2 from 9 a.m. until 12:30p.m. at the Community Presbyterian Church of Mt. Bethel/Portland 1755 S. Delaware Drive, Mt. Bethel, Pa. I would encourage all of you to come and hear the Rev. Stanley Ott, Founder and President of the Vital Churches Institute who will speak about congregational vitality, transformation, missional endeavor and leadership. If you can't make this wonderful opportunity, I would still encourage you to pray for the Lehigh Presbytery and our church as we enter into some new and exciting, but often uncomfortable times.
