If you asked anyone who has attended Sunday school for a number of years, what is the shortest verse in the Bible, you will likely get..."Jesus wept". This is not the only two-word verse in the Bible. There are actually several two-and three-word verses. They all have something in common. They are short, simple and straight-to-the-point. One of these simple and straight-to-the-point verses that have come to my mind recently is "pray without ceasing" (1 Thes. 5:17). Prayer is an important, if not one of the most important, parts of being a disciple of Christ. Prayer is how we communicate with God.

I have been convinced of this lately. I have found myself getting frustrated with people and not turning to God in prayer about it, but reacting on my own accord. Yet, I am reminded that if we truly prayed without ceasing, which is very hard to do, we might not find ourselves caught up over disagreements that really don't matter. The next time you find yourself angry, upset or anxious, recall the simple, straight-to-the-point verse, "pray without ceasing" and ask God what you should do in this situation. God might just remind you to let it go and trust that He will resolve it in His perfect way and time. Let us help each other, including me, to pray without ceasing. To pray God's will be done, not ours, and together the Spirit can continue to grow in us even more.
