Dear friends and members,

On January 23rd, the sermon was focused on evangelism in our conversations. I recognize this can be difficult for many. This week I came across this illustration that I thought would be helpful in understanding even more about how to share Christ with others. Shannon K. Evans in her book, Embracing Weakness: The Unlikely Secret to Changing the World, shares this, "If my testimony of the gospel revolves around a plotline of, 'I used to struggle with this, but God gave me the victory and now I'm free/healed/saved/fill in the blank,' I have immediately distanced myself from the listener of my testimony by implying that I have arrived in a place where they are not". No doubt we do find freedom, healing, and salvation in Christ — and want that for others, too — but the reality continues to be that we, ourselves, are also in process. The power of the gospel is not that we no longer suffer or struggle, but that we no longer do so alone. If we feel called to share our faith during a conversation, we should keep in mind, as she notes, where they are at in their spiritual journey so as to invite them to hear about Jesus in a non-threatening, non-exclusive way as Jesus exampled.
