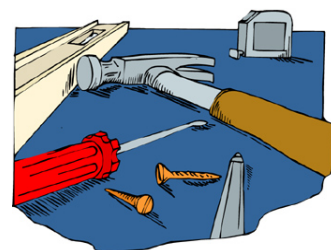


Join us on a Mission Work Trip with *Helping Hands* to New Bern, NC
APRIL 23-30, 2022



WHAT	Helping Hands of Lehigh Presbytery will make a mission work trip to assist in the recovery efforts in North Carolina after hurricanes and flooding caused extensive damage to churches and homes in that area.
WHEN	April 23-30, 2022
WHERE	New Bern, North Carolina
WHO	Adult women and men – 16 and older ready to help and provide hope to others (Ages 16 and 17 need to be accompanied by an adult)
WORK	Reconstruction projects on homes damaged by storms and flooding. No specific skills or experience are required, but be prepared to BE FLEXIBLE and provide whatever help is needed. Skills such as plumbing, electrical, roofing, and dry wall installation are always welcomed.
LODGING	We will be staying at the Neuse Forest Presbyterian Church, 2011 Old Cherry Point Road, New Bern, NC 28560. There are showers and bathrooms available on site. Please bring sleeping bags.
FOOD AND WATER	Meals will be provided. (Bring a reusable water bottle)
TRAVEL	Transportation for this trip will be by rented mini-vans and a cargo van to transport tools.
COST TO PARTICIPANTS	\$200 for the week. Must register by March 18, 2022. This registration fee covers all expenses except meals in route and incidental personal expenses. PROOF OF COVID VACCINATION REQUIRED.
