We hear every day about increasing housing costs, evictions, foreclosures, and other causes of housing insecurity in our communities. On **Sunday, July 30**, we invite you to gather in the lounge for the fellowship time and conversation on these issues that confront countless neighborhoods and families here and across our country. We'll play and discuss The Game of Rent, a board game-style simulation designed to promote productive conversations about affordable housing. In the words of its creators, "using local data (we'll be using a version specially designed for the Lehigh Valley) and the luck of the draw, the Game helps

build empathy and awareness around housing issues." We will conclude by considering what we and other concerned citizens can do to help alleviate the current housing crisis in our community. Feel free to invite others to come for this exciting learning experience.
