I have to say frustration isn't the first word that comes to mind when I am thinking about love. Yet, I realize that he is referencing Ephesians 5:21 "Out of reverence for Christ, yield to one another." As Bernard will explain, often in a relationship be it partner, family, church, or any relationship, one individual may want to do something that we don't want or don't like. It may even be the opposite of what we want. Yet, this passage reminds us that, out of love and reverence for Jesus, we are to be willing to be frustrated.

We are to yield to the other person's preference and to do so without grumbling or complaining. We are called to be willing to suffer that they may know joy, just like Jesus suffered so that we may know joy. Keep in mind though, that a healthy relationship will see this type of love go back and forth. It is not suggesting allowing abuse, but to let more go of what we might think is the right way. In these times it's easy to let our frustrations get the best of us and act out in angered ways. May we choose though, to be like Christ, allowing ourselves to be willing to be frustrated to show Christ love.
