Although this year is one in which Easter is later, the Lenten season remains 40 days of time (not Sundays) where disciples, in honor of Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness, take time to pray, study scriptures, fast and prepare our hearts for Easter. Some choose to give up things as a way of fasting from something. Others choose to take something on as a way of displaying a fast on their time. Lent is also a great opportunity to sacrifice some more time than just a Sunday morning worship to study scriptures and pray more. During this Lent we have opportunities to grow spiritually when we commit our time to the Lord. There are opportunities to do so starting with the first day of Lent by attending the Ash Wednesday hybrid service at 6:00pm on March 2. If you can't do an evening time, you can also come in to receive Ashes from 12-1pm. In the weeks following, there is an opportunity to participate in a Meal and Message Lenten Bible Study. (more information below) Additionally, there will be evening services on Maundy Thursday and Good Friday, which is an ecumenical service. In this season of Lent, may we fast of our time, repent, pray, study and grow in the grace and knowledge of our Savior.
